WEALTH OF CROATIA(WATER)

- ❖ Water is our wealth
- Croatia has the highest water supply in EU
- Our country has 26 billion cubic meters of water a year
- Jamnica is our biggest producer of mineral water (190 years)
- Because of how clean our water is, it is completely safe to drink tap water, in all regions!
- Southern Croatia has the cleanest water
- More than 87% of Croatian population uses public water supply and drinks tap water
- Tourists are often suprised about how clean our water is

ADRIATIC SEA (Jadransko more)

- There are 1244 islands
- The sea is very clean and clear
- The sea is relatively warm
- The Adriatic sea is considered one of the saltiest seas in the world.
- The average depth of the Adriatic Sea is 173 meters
- A lot of tourists say that our sea is the most beautiful sea in the world

LAKES

- The lakes are divided into 2 groups: natural lakes and artificial lakes
- Vransko lake is the largest natural lake in Croatia
- 2 most popular artificial lakes in Croatia are Bundek and Jarun, both located in Zagreb
- People often swim in Bundek and Jarun (although its not recommended)










RIVERS

- We have many rivers that connect us with other countries: Mura, Drava, Danube(Dunav), Kupa, Zrmanja, Sava and others
- The longest river in Croatia is river Kupa
- Kupa is 296 kilometers long in Croatia
- The most popular river in Croatia is Sava
- There are around 30 big rivers in Croatia



WATER CARE

Croatia has people that are taking care of our water

Tips for taking care of water:

- 1. When you brush your teeth turn off the tap!
- 2. Don't take long baths, take a quick shower!
- 3. Water the plants with rainwater!
- 4. Don't be wastefull and save the planet!




WATER POLLUTION

- 3. Use natural energy(sun, wind etc...) and not non reusable resources!






